### APPENDIX C - RELATIONAL HEALTH ADVENTURE

A Relational Health Adventure invites you into a realistic, immersive experience that reveals the relational health of your school, which is your ability to build and maintain loving, safe, resilient and God-honoring relationships, even in the face of life's challenges and conflicts.

Unlike a school health survey that measures perceptions, opinions or levels of satisfaction, this experience walks you through a realistic living story. As you move through it together, you won't be asked what you think a healthy school *should do*. You'll be asked to decide what *your leadership team* would *probably do* when pressure rises, tensions converge and the stakes are real.

The adventure unfolds through a series of realistic events and decision points. Each successive step will be shaped by the decision you believe your leadership would make in that circumstance. Thus, the adventure will be uniquely *your adventure*, revealing whether your school is inclined to respond to life's challenges in an impulsive, clumsy and

detrimental manner or in a way that shows constructive discernment, wisdom and self-control.

As a result, this adventure does something surveys cannot do. It surfaces actual patterns. It reveals habits. It exposes the reflexes that shape culture over time, especially under pressure. And it does so gently, without accusation, by letting the story serve as a mirror to reveal how your school typically deals with real-life relational challenges.

After you complete your adventure, you will see where your school stands on the spectrum of relational health, which ranges from toxic to flourishing. No matter where your school is on this spectrum, you can change and grow. By God's grace, a toxic school can become a healthy school, a healthy school can become a flourishing school, and a flourishing school can learn new ways to expand its gospel impact in its community.

### School Wide Strategies

1. To **build support for relational skills training** for your school, share [Challenging Relational Scenarios in a Christian School](#) and [Reconciliation in a Christian School](#) with your board of directors and staff and discuss the potential benefits of strengthening the relational skills of your staff, students and parents.

3. Introduce your board of directors and staff to the key skills and benefits of relational wisdom and peacemaking by **hosting a live [half-day or all-day seminar](#)**.

7. 8. 9. **Serve your wider community** (and raise the visibility and prestige of your school) by encouraging two or three gifted staff members to obtain advanced training as PACE (Professional and Community Engagement) Instructors who can take relational wisdom and peacemaking training into local businesses and nonprofit organizations (see [Using Relational Wisdom for Outreach and Evangelism](#) and [PACE Program](#)). Your RW Instructors could also present periodic relational wisdom and peacemaking seminars that are advertised to your wider community and introduce people to your school.

### Classroom Strategies

1. Use [Young Peacemaker](#) resources to **teach peacemaking to grade school children**. Set up a "Peace Table" in your classroom where students can go to work through conflicts. Stock the table with laminated summaries of key peacemaking principles.
2. Use 3-4 minute [Relational Heroes video clips](#) to inspire students to imitate Jesus by looking for opportunities to show kindness to the people around them.
3. **Inspire high school students to grow in relational wisdom** by discussing Jeff Sande's insightful testimony, [Overcoming Artificial Maturity with Relational Wisdom](#).
4. Encourage high school students to use RW360's [online course in relational wisdom](#) to earn a "**Certificate in Enhanced Emotional Intelligence**," which will improve their relational skills and enhance their resumes as they compete for college scholarships and future jobs (see [EI for Teens](#) and [EI for College and Beyond](#)).
